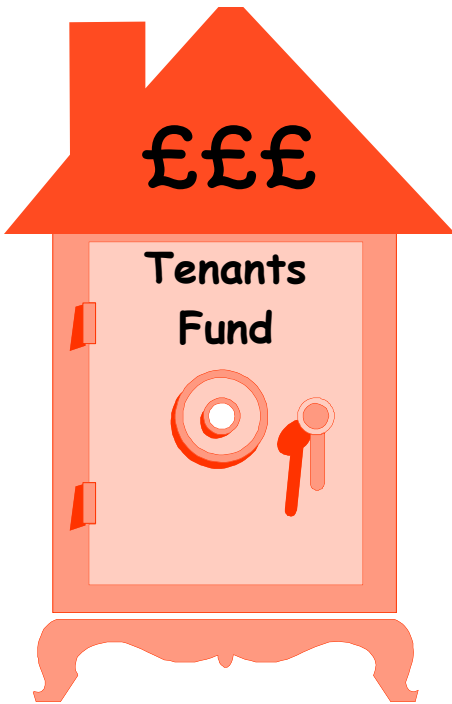

What is the purpose of the Tenants Fund?

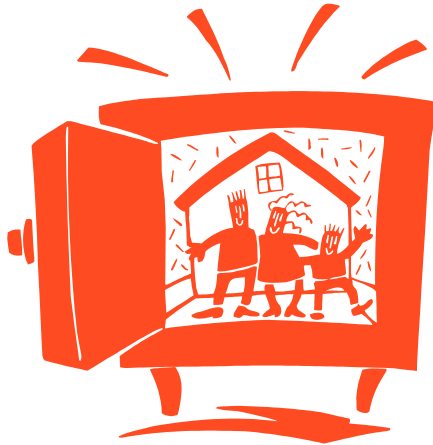
In Newcastle there is money available for tenants and residents groups to cover their running costs.

Groups are eligible if they represent council tenants and actively address issues around housing and related topics.

Where does the money come from?

Newcastle City Council provides the grants from income they receive through your rents. The Tenants Federation administers the fund and can offer book-keeping training to enable you to monitor your group's spending.

How much funding can groups apply for and what can the money be used for?



Grants vary, depending on the number of Council properties in the area and the needs of each group **but all groups can expect a minimum of £150.** Most groups use their grant to cover costs such as room hire for meetings, crèches and refreshments.

Other expenses which can be funded include interpretation, stationery, production of publicity materials (e.g. printing, photocopying, posters, newsletters and leaflets), travel costs, fun days, events and other relevant activities. We can discuss your financial needs when you make your application.
